12 / 2023 - 01 | Welcome

Chairman welcomed Cllrs and members of the public and explained the meeting had been changed to accommodate the carol service and the recent amendments to the hall. It was noted the meeting is being recorded.

12 / 2023 - 03 | Declarations of Interest

12 / 2023 – 04 | To agree the minutes of the last meeting (17th October 2023)

12 / 2023 – 05 | Outcomes from the actions of the last meeting

Action items recorded in the previous meeting minutes were completed apart from:

CB contacting Land Registry etc to try and clarify land boundaries

CB will contact the allotment association about required clearing

Waiting Oaktree to confirm date for planning 10 new cherry trees – ND

The Chair reported on the following matters.

- telephone box has been cleared of unwanted fiction once more
- new windows will be looked at in the new year. **ACTION ND**
- Christmas tree and lights are working, risk assessment on website.

12 / 2023 – 09 | District Councillor Report

Cllr Bush gave updates on the following points:

- waste contract review is underway and fortnightly collections should remain for black bag waste, rural runs still being considered, legislation is a moving part in terms of recycling, glass could be collected moving forward
- recycling boxes and their replacement is an issue and the council cannot keep giving them out if broken etc. You will be able to get new bins if you can prove they are broken. You can use any plastic box of your own to put recycling in
- TDC land ownership review - two parcels in Great Oakley, although they are muted as not being suitable. Could come back to the PC for lease etc
- The car rally will not take place in 2024 as being asked to pay for use of car parks
- Environment and climate change action plan is in need of review. It will be looked at to achieve cost savings and environmental improvements
- Council tax base is looking at around 3% uplift for 24/25
- 20 million LUFF fund for Tendring to be utilised including Dovercourt.

12 / 2023 – 11 | Reports

Parish Council Maintained Areas

Cllr Bailey reported the Burial Ground Garden has been cleared and replanted and thanked the memorial garden team volunteers for all their hard work and recommended the new charging regime to be implemented Action YB

The new covered waste bin has been installed outside play area and appears to be being emptied. All to monitor to check if capacity sufficient.



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Public Rights of Way / Highways / Pavements

Cllr Browne reported that cars are parking on the road verge by Allotments, Cllr Harris updated that an email had gone out to parents recently. Cllr Bush asked if signs could be installed in the area. **ACTIONS: agenda item for next meeting. Consider getting a quote for a mapping service of the village ND. 40MPH sign in Red Barn Lane is down- Check CB has reported on Highways website Water pump - ND to follow up**

Great Oakley Environment, Villages in Bloom, Planters

Cllr Daniels reported, a bag of compost will be offered to planter folk in New Year – **Action ND.**

TDALC

Cllr Bailey reported a technical issue has meant she was unable to take part in the whole meeting but there was little to report.

Village Hall and New Community Facilities

Updates since last meeting have been circulated and motions are on the agenda tonight.

ND gave thanks to those that have put a huge amount of work in.

SH reported: porch improved, windows in porch and door lock renewed, kitchen refurb, hall repainted, community garden is now fenced and improved, step now installed from kitchen to garden, door on electricity box repaired, hand dryers/towel dispensers are up in kitchen and toilets, new booking system is to be launched in January 2024. Price increase to £12 an hour from the new year. We have applied for a grant for a heating system. We have contacted the outgoing caretaker of the hall to confirm GDPR requirements for the email account are met and voiced concern on the “Users” Facebook page – **ACTION ND to circulate formal request and response.** Keys have been put back into the mail box on the hall.

12 / 2023 – 12 | New Community Centre / Facilities

Cllr Bush gave an update and explained the challenges of the matter so far. There is approval for the housing but the expiry date has come and gone and owning the delays by TDC there is an extension moving forward to clarify the particulars.

Agreed the address for the legal document is the village hall

Further keys to be cut for post box -VHC will agree collection regime with Clerk

Questions from Ellisons regarding the S106 were discussed and responses agreed which Cllr Bush will do cc Chair and Clerk. **Action MB**
